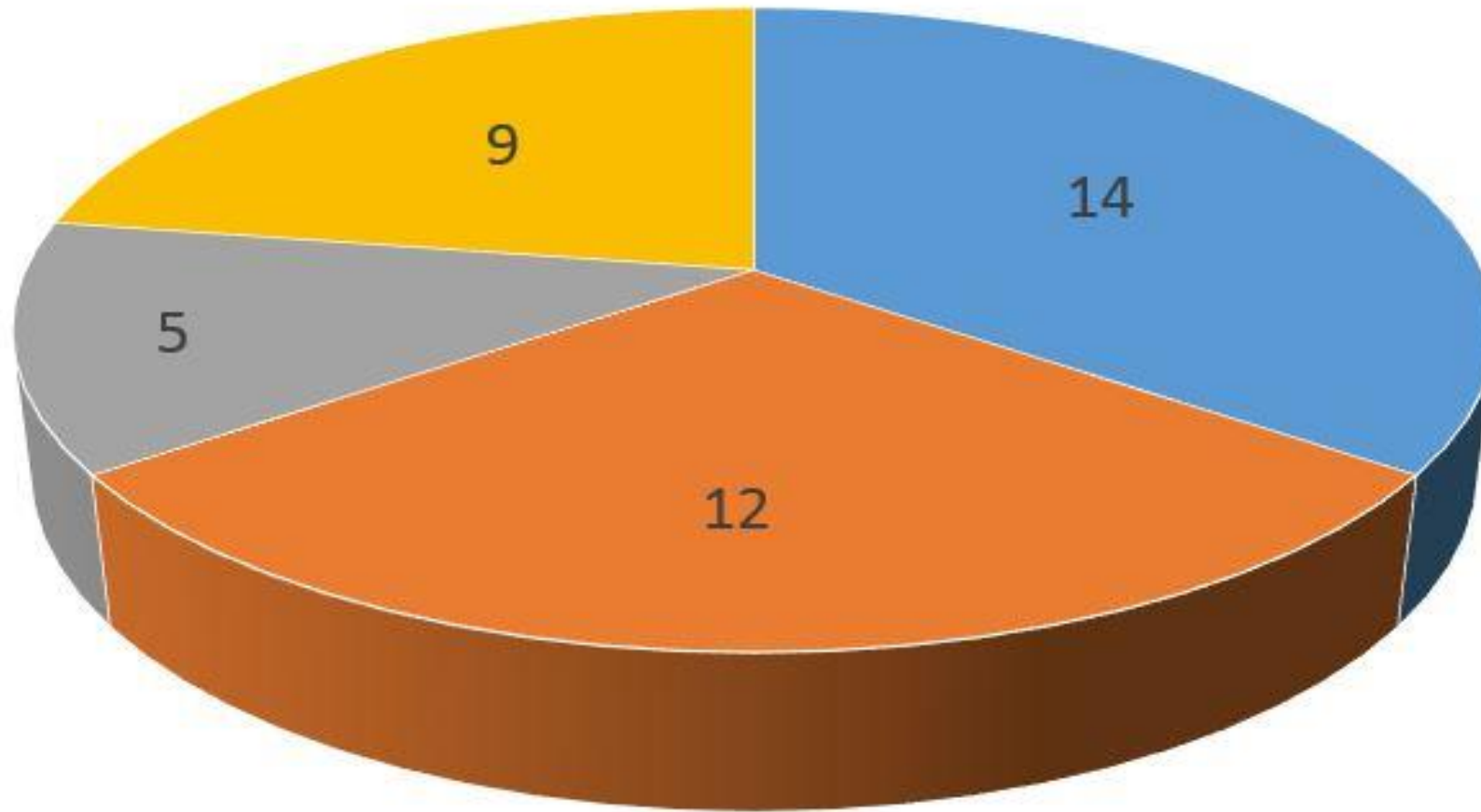

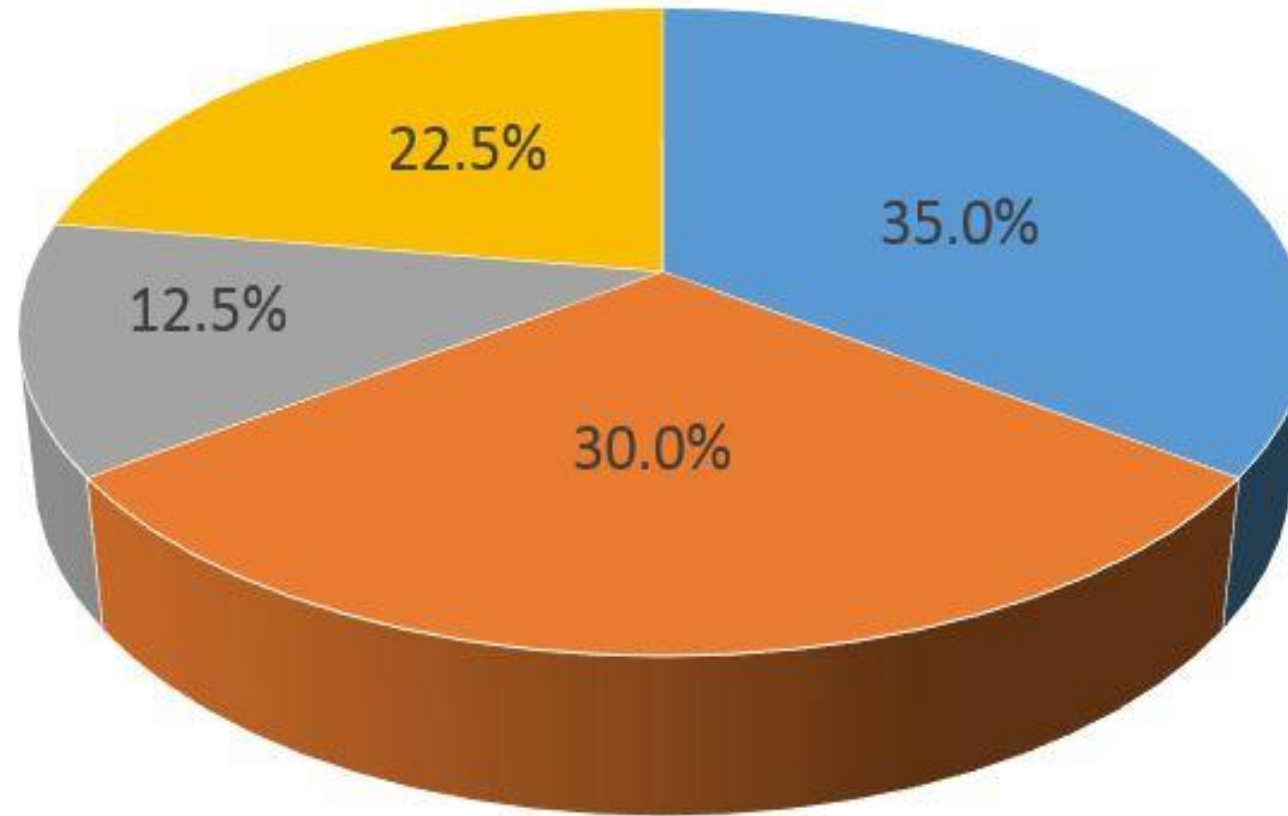

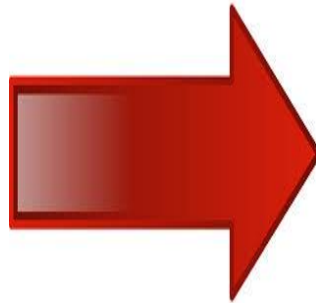

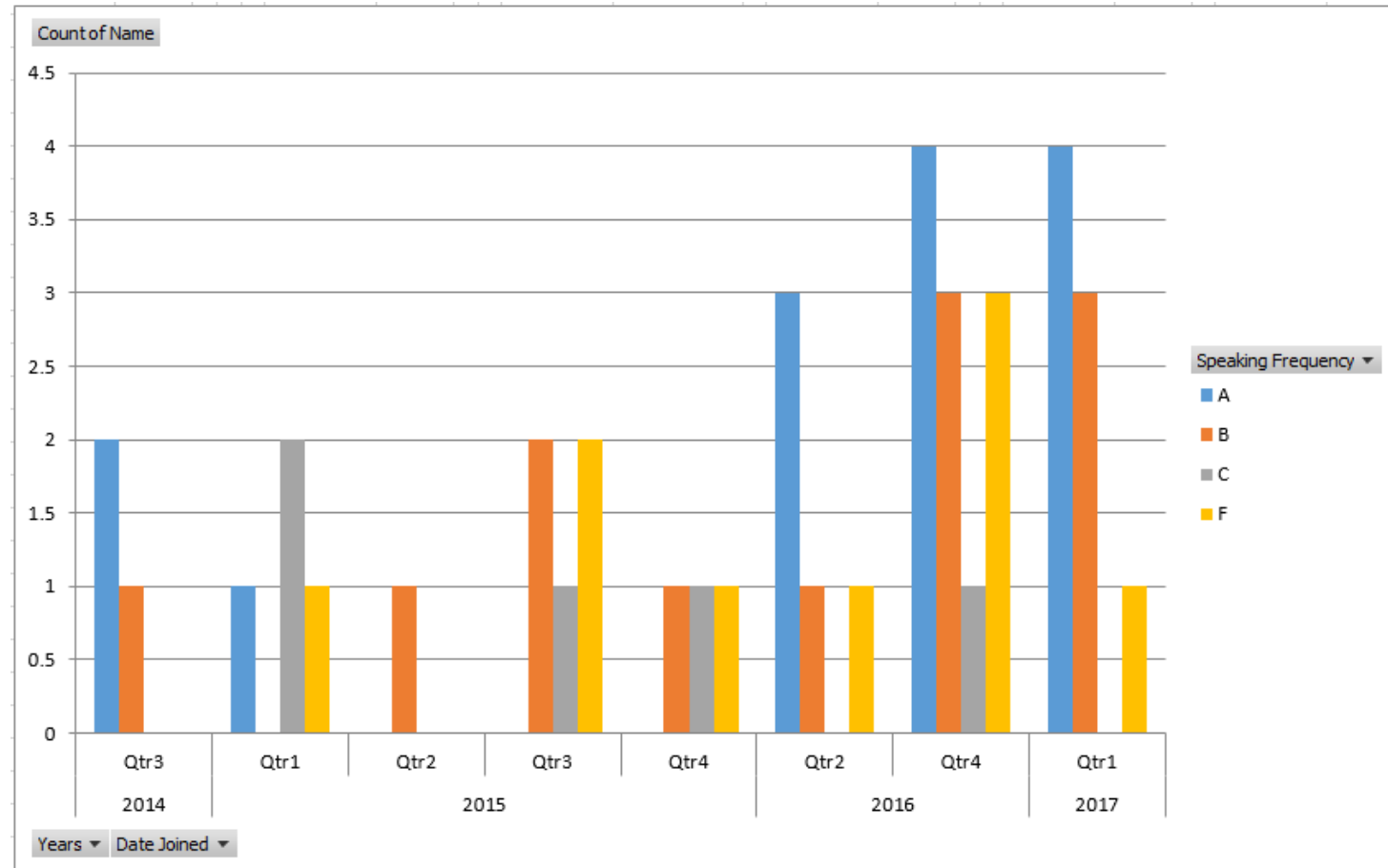

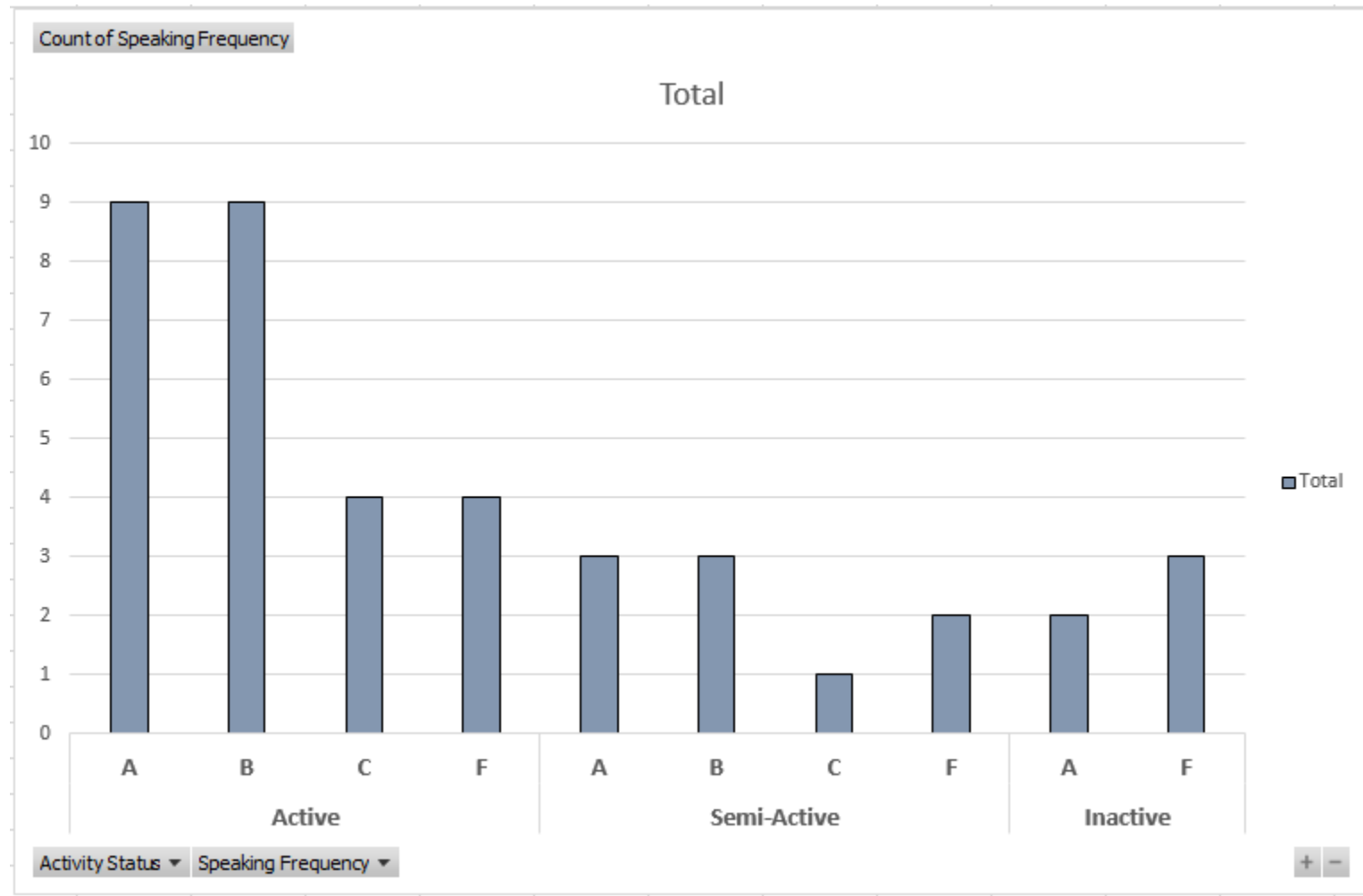




Speaking Preference By Join Date

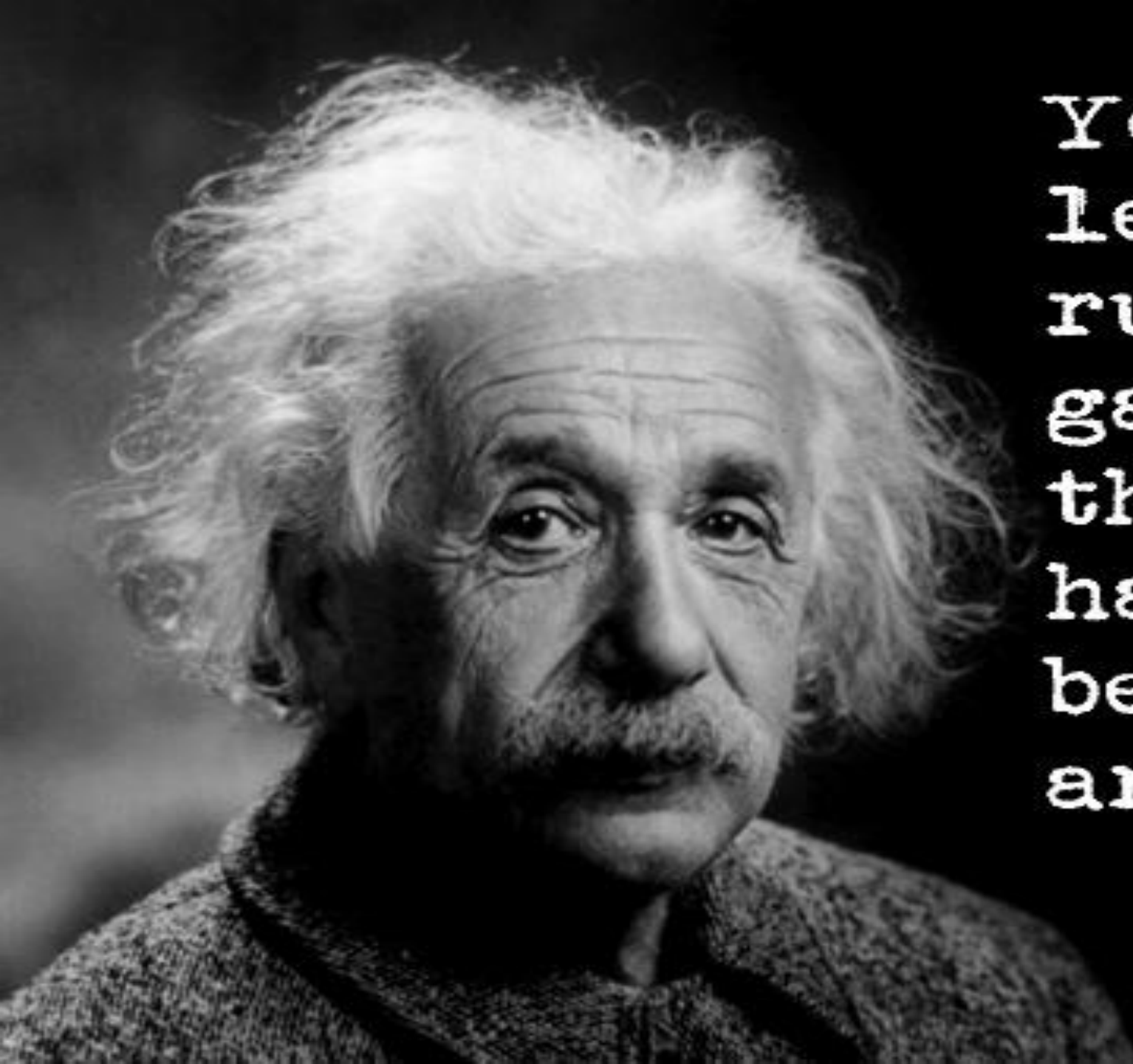
